DIRECTIONS

Coming into Oxford going North on Hwy 7 or east or west on Hwy 6: In Oxford go North on Hwy 7. After the University Drive & Sisk turn right onto 30 and go 1.3 miles. Look for the BP station, "Littlejohn's" on the Left and Shell Station on the Right. Turn Left there onto CR 215. Go 1.8 miles and the road splits. Go Right onto CR 202. Go 1.6 miles to a paved driveway on the Right. The number is clearly on the box, # 148. We have white Centaur Fencing along the road.

1. Check CWF web site for schedule Thursday before show.
2. Ribbons for Dressage Tests and for Combined Tests.
3. Dressage Show ribbons based on % scores not placing.
4. All arenas are sand and/or crushed limestone. Warm up dressage indoor or the arena not being used outside.
5. Warm up for jumping: in valley south of the jump arena. Enter Valley from the South end. x-country: By start gate
6. Negative Coggins within 12 months. Send copy with entries.
7. All CT and Intro ridden in small arena. All others in Large Arena.
8. Attire: Dress informal. Proper footwear and ASTM approved helmets mandatory for all jumping activities and all junior riders whenever mounted. Safety vests are required for jump phases.
9. USAE rules/USPC Eventing rally rules will apply.
10. This CT is recognized by MsEDA for yearend awards. Dressage Show is recognized by MsEDA & DDA toward year end awards.
11. Parking can be a bit tight. Look for a parking assistant.
12. In case of cancellation all entries are refunded. If scratch is necessary all but office fee is refunded until Friday noon before show. After that, no refunds.
13. We will try to have a small concession by Southern Run PC.
14. Dogs of pleasant nature on leashes are welcome.
